(1) The Governor may award a Medal of 10 Heroism of appropriate design, with ribbons and appurtenances, 11 12 to a law enforcement, correctional, or correctional probation officer, as defined in section 943.10(14), Florida Statutes; a 13 14 firefighter, as defined in section 112.191(1)(b), Florida 15 Statutes; an emergency medical technician, as defined in section 401.23(11), Florida Statutes; or a paramedic, as 16 17 defined in section 401.23(17), Florida Statutes. A recipient must have distinguished himself or herself conspicuously by 18 19 gallantry and intrepidity; must have risked his or her life 20 deliberately above and beyond the call of duty while performing duty in his or her respective position; and must 21 have engaged in hazardous or perilous activities to preserve 22 23 lives with the knowledge that such activities might result in 24 great personal harm. (2) A candidate or person seeking to nominate a 25 26 candidate for the award must make written application to the 27 Governor. The Governor may refer an application to any public or private entity for advice and recommendations regarding the 28 29 application. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. 31
