A 23 purchaser of property may avoid this inference by contacting the identified owner, if the identifying or ownership 24 25 information is decipherable, to confirm that the property has 26 not been misappropriated, or, if the identifying or ownership 27 information is not decipherable, by contacting local law 28 enforcement to inquire as to whether the property may have 29 been misappropriated. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 31 law.
