Any action that would substantially 4 5 alter the reserve as it existed on January 1, 2003, must be б approved by law. 7 (1) Public hunting is allowed in the state reserve as 8 authorized by the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. 9 (2) The Division of State Lands of the Department of 10 Environmental Protection may acquire in the name of the Board 11 of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund any additional property adjacent or contiguous to the Rodman 12 Reservoir State Reserve from private owners or from the United 13 14 States Government for improved management and recreational 15 opportunities. The Division of State Lands shall identify, 16 (3) 17 contact, and inform all property owners who hold easements located within the taking line of the Rodman Reservoir of the 18 19 designation of this area as a state reserve.
