Subsection (2) of section 465.017, Florida 9 Statutes, is amended to read: 10 465.017 Authority to inspect; disposal.--11 (2) (a) Except as permitted by this chapter, and chapters 12 406, 409, 456, 499, and 893, records maintained in a pharmacy 13 relating to the filling of prescriptions and the dispensing of 14 15 medicinal drugs shall not be furnished to any person other than to the patient for whom the drugs were dispensed, or her or his 16 legal representative, or to the department pursuant to existing 17 law, or, in the event that the patient is incapacitated or 18 unable to request said records, her or his spouse except upon 19 the written authorization of such patient. Such records may be 20 furnished in any civil or criminal proceeding, upon the issuance 21 of a subpoena from a court of competent jurisdiction and proper 22 notice to the patient or her or his legal representative by the 23 party seeking such records. 24 The board shall adopt rules to establish practice 25 (b)

guidelines for pharmacies to dispose of records maintained in a 26 pharmacy relating to the filling of prescriptions and the 27 dispensing of medicinal drugs. Such rules shall be consistent 28 with the duty to preserve the confidentiality of such records in 29

accordance with applicable state and federal law. 30
