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Senator Wasserman Schultz moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment**

On page 7, line 25, after the period

insert: If a nursing home on the watch list fails to comply with the minimum-staffing requirements in this sub-subparagraph for 2 consecutive days, it may not accept new admissions until it has achieved the minimum-staffing requirements for 6 consecutive days. A resident of the facility who is absent from the facility for medical treatment at a separate location is considered to be on a leave of absence. A resident of a continuing care facility, as defined in s. 651.011(9), is not considered a new admission. Failure to impose an admissions moratorium is a class II deficiency.
