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A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to education; creating the Care to Learn Program; providing purpose; requiring public schools to provide to parents, within a specified time after the parent's child enrolls in the school, certain information about the child's educational program; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Care to Learn Program; creation; purpose; requirements.--

(1) The Care to Learn Program is created for the purpose of promoting parental involvement and empowering parents in all aspects of their children's educational programs and service choices.

(2) Within 30 days after a student enrolls in a public school, the school shall provide the child's parents with the following information:

(a) What the parent should expect from the school and the school district with respect to the student's being a customer;

(b) A copy of the school's parent and community involvement policy;

(c) Opportunities for the parent to volunteer in the school;

(d) The role of the parents in the school advisory council;

(e) Academic standards, class requirements, and promotion requirements that the student is expected to meet;
