(1) The Department of Law Enforcement shall conduct a study regarding the establishment of minimum 13 standards for latent fingerprint examiners. The study shall: 14 (a) Examine currently available training for latent 15 16 fingerprint examiners; (b) Determine which training providers offer training 17 and instruction that meets or exceeds the standards 18 19 established by the American Society of Crime Laboratory 20 Directors Laboratory Accreditation Board (ASCLD-LAB); and 21 (c) Determine whether such training can best be 22 provided through the department or through a law enforcement 23 agency other than the department. (2) The department shall provide a written report of 24 25 its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of 26 27 Representatives by July 1, 2004. 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 29 law. 30 31
