SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that amendments to the water resource implementation rule of the Florida water plan require legislative approval. Authorizes the adoption of rules providing for water reservations under the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan Regulation Act. Provides that the consumption or use of domestic wastewater effluent is 22 23 24 exempt from certain permit requirements. Repeals a provision authorizing water reservations for purposes of protecting fish and wildlife or the public health and 25 26 safety. 27 28 29 30 31
