the collection of retroactive child support payments and reimbursement for attorney's fees for parents or government agencies attempting to collect such child support payments.

10 WHEREAS, the collection of past-due child support 11 payments from deadbeat parents is an expensive, 12 time-consuming, and difficult process, and

13 WHEREAS, many deadbeat parents receive payments under 14 the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. ss. 651 et seq., and 15 WHEREAS, payments for past-due child support and for 16 attorney's fees for the collection of past-due child support 17 to parents or government agencies should be deducted from 18 social security payments before social security payments are 19 made, and

WHEREAS, the Social Security Act should be amended to permit the deduction of funds for the payment of past-due child support and reimbursement for attorney's fees for the collection of past-due child support to parents or government agencies prior to the payment of social security funds to recipients, and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States would be doing a great service to many dependent children in this country by revising the Social Security Act to provide for the payment of past-due child support and reimbursement for attorney's fees for the collection of past-due child support
