Notwithstanding any provisions relating to competitive bid procedures required pursuant to chapter 255 or 13 14 chapter 287, Florida Statutes, the governing body of any municipality, political subdivision, or agency, except as 15 otherwise provided by law, is authorized to contract with a 16 17 not-for-profit charitable youth organization that meets the qualifications of s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 18 19 as amended, and that is organized exclusively to provide 20 public service work such as highway and park maintenance by at-risk youths enrolled in a work-study program. Contracts 21 22 shall be production-based and shall have a maximum annual 23 award limit of \$250,000 for any municipality, political subdivision, or agency. All such contracts shall be approved 24 25 by the governing body of the municipality or by authorized 26 agency personnel, as appropriate. 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 28 law. 29 30 31 1
