Disgualifications.--(a) No person convicted of a felony, or adjudicated in 21 22 this or any other state to be mentally incompetent, shall be 23 qualified to vote or hold office until restoration of civil 24 rights or removal of disability. No person convicted of a 25 felony shall be qualified to vote until the person's right to register or vote has been restored as provided by law. No 26 27 person adjudicated in this state to be mentally incompetent 28 shall be qualified to vote until removal of disability. 29 (b) No person may appear on the ballot for re-election 30 to any of the following offices: 31 (1) Florida representative, 1
