The Department of Health shall provide the Legislature with an annual report that analyzes the quality of 18 19 the reclaimed water that is reused in this state in ways that 20 involve potential human exposure and provide recommendations 21 to ensure that such reuse is The Legislature finds that the 22 use of reclaimed water provided by domestic wastewater 23 treatment plants permitted and operated under a reuse program 24 approved by the department is environmentally acceptable and 25 not a threat to public health and safety. Section 2. 7	involve potential human exposure and provide recommendations
8	to ensure that such reuse is The Legislature further finds
9	that for those wastewater treatment plants permitted and
10	operated under an approved reuse program by the department,
11	the reclaimed water shall be considered environmentally
12	acceptable and not a threat to public health and safety.
13	Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
14	law.
