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The Committee on Natural Resources recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 5, between lines 8 and 9,

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (17) of s. 403.703, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

403.703 Definitions.--As used in this act, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the term:

(17) "Construction and demolition debris" means discarded materials generally considered to be not water-soluble and nonhazardous in nature, including, but not limited to, steel, glass, brick, concrete, asphalt roofing material, pipe, gypsum wallboard, and lumber, from the construction or destruction of a structure as part of a construction or demolition project or from the renovation of a structure, and including rocks, soils, tree remains, trees, and other vegetative matter that normally results from land clearing or land development operations for a construction

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1 project, including such debris from construction of structures  
2 at a site remote from the construction or demolition project  
3 site. Mixing of construction and demolition debris with other  
4 types of solid waste will cause it to be classified as other  
5 than construction and demolition debris. The term also  
6 includes:

7 (a) Clean cardboard, paper, plastic, wood, and metal  
8 scraps from a construction project;

9 (b) Except as provided in s. 403.707(12)(j),  
10 unpainted, nontreated wood scraps from facilities  
11 manufacturing materials used for construction of structures or  
12 their components and unpainted, nontreated wood pallets  
13 provided the wood scraps and pallets are separated from other  
14 solid waste where generated and the generator of such wood  
15 scraps or pallets implements reasonable practices of the  
16 generating industry to minimize the commingling of wood scraps  
17 or pallets with other solid waste; ~~and~~

18 (c) Nonhazardous fiber reinforced cement scrap waste  
19 from facilities manufacturing fiber reinforced cement products  
20 for the construction industry provided the waste is separated  
21 from other solid waste where generated and the generator of  
22 such waste implements reasonable practices of the generating  
23 industry to minimize commingling of the fiber reinforced  
24 cement scrap waste with other solid waste; and

25 ~~(d)(e)~~ De minimis amounts of other nonhazardous wastes  
26 that are generated at construction or destruction projects,  
27 provided such amounts are consistent with best management  
28 practices of the industry.
