Counties and municipalities that own sites 15 with soil or water contamination shall remediate such sites to 16 17 the same extent as is required for brownfield sites under section 376.81, Florida Statutes. 18 19 Section 3. The Department of Environmental Protection 20 may adopt such rules and issue such orders as may be necessary 21 to carry out the provisions of this act. 22 Section 4. The provisions of this act may be enforced pursuant to sections 120.69, 120.695, 376.83, 403.141, 23 403.161, and 403.412, Florida Statutes. 24 25 Section 5. If any provision of this act or of the 26 rules adopted pursuant to this act is in conflict with any 27 other provision, limitation, or restriction which is now in 28 effect under any law of this state or any ordinance of a local 29 government, political subdivision, or municipality, or any 30 rule or regulation adopted thereunder, the provisions of this act or of the rules adopted pursuant to this act shall

control; provided, however, that a local government, political subdivision, or municipality is not prohibited from adopting and enforcing more stringent provisions. Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
