Notwithstanding any 32 other provision of law, a maximum of \$180 million of lottery 33 revenues transferred to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund 34 in fiscal year 1997-1998 and for 30 years thereafter shall be 35 reserved as needed and used to meet the requirements of the 36 documents authorizing the bonds issued by the state pursuant to 37 s. 1013.68 or s. 1013.70 or distributed to school districts for 38 the Classrooms First Program as provided in s. 1013.68. Such 39 lottery revenues are hereby pledged to the payment of debt 40 41 service on bonds issued by the state pursuant to s. 1013.68 or s. 1013.70. Debt service payable on bonds issued by the state 42 43 pursuant to s. 1013.68 or s. 1013.70 shall be payable from the 44 first lottery revenues transferred to the Educational 45 Enhancement Trust Fund in each fiscal year. Amounts distributable to school districts that request the issuance of 46 bonds pursuant to s. 1013.68(3) are hereby pledged to such bonds 47 pursuant to s. 11(d), Art. VII of the State Constitution.
