Subsection (1) of section 322.27, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 13 14 322.27 Authority of department to suspend or revoke 15 license.--(1) Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in 16 17 chapter 120, the department is hereby authorized to suspend the license of any person without preliminary hearing upon a 18 19 showing of its records or other sufficient evidence that the 20 licensee: (a) Has committed an offense for which mandatory 21 22 revocation of license is required upon conviction. A law 23 enforcement agency must notify the department when any of its officers issues a citation or makes an arrest for an offense 24 25 covered by this paragraph; (b) Has been convicted of a violation of any traffic 26 27 law which resulted in a crash that caused the death or 28 personal injury of another or property damage in excess of 29 \$500; 30 (c) Is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle; 31 1

1	(d) Has permitted an unlawful or fraudulent use of
2	such license or has knowingly been a party to the obtaining of
3	a license by fraud or misrepresentation or to display, or
4	represent as one's own, any driver's license not issued him or
5	her. Provided, however, no provision of this section shall be
6	construed to include the provisions of s. 322.32(1);
7	(e) Has committed an offense in another state which if
8	committed in this state would be grounds for suspension or
9	revocation; or
10	(f) Has committed a second or subsequent violation of
11	s. 316.172(1) within a 5-year period of any previous
12	violation.
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
