Subsection (6) is added to section 1008.37, 15 Florida Statutes, to read: 16 17 1008.37 Postsecondary feedback of information to high schools.--18 19 (6) Each public postsecondary educational institution in this state shall, each semester, electronically provide to 20 21 each district school board in this state information about the 22 college grades and performance of each student enrolled in that educational institution who graduated from high school in 23 that district. The purpose of this report is to provide each 24 25 school district with information that can be used to evaluate how well the instructional programs in that district have 26 27 prepared students for postsecondary education. The information that must be electronically transmitted from each educational 28 29 institution to the appropriate school district must include 30 data elements that are already gathered at the postsecondary level, including, but not limited to, the individual student's 31

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first and second major courses of study and minor courses, if applicable; cumulative grade point average; cumulative credits attempted and earned; and degree earned. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to administer this subsection. б Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. SENATE SUMMARY Requires each postsecondary educational institution periodically to electronically transmit to each district school board a report of the academic performance of each student enrolled in that institution who graduated from high school in that district. Provides for the State Board of Education to adopt rules.

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
