Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 8, between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 4. Subsections (3) and (4) are added to section 471.031, Florida Statutes, to read:

471.031 Prohibitions; penalties.--

(3) The prohibitions of this section shall not apply to any employee or contractor of a sole proprietorship, firm, limited liability company, partnership, joint stock association, corporation, or other business entity that:

(a) Provides products, services, or a project, as defined in s. 288.1045(1)(i), to an agency or department of the United States, any agency or department of a state government, or the government of a foreign country which involves the design, development, production, sale, or provision of defense or aerospace products or services;

(b) Consists of or supports commercial aircraft and the entity holds a certificate issued by the Federal Aviation

3 (c) Consists of space vehicles or space services that
4 are subject to licensing or regulation by an agency or
5 department of the United States under Title 14, 47 or 48 of
6 the Code of Federal Regulations, or for sale or use outside
7 the United States; or

8 (d) Allows the use of the term "engineer" or
9 "engineering" in a job title or personnel classification of an
10 employee or contractor to the extent that the use of the title
11 or classification is related to activities described in this
12 subsection.

14 This subsection expires July 1, 2004, unless reenacted by the
15 Legislature before that date.

16 (4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
17 chapter, a person who is not required to be licensed under s.
18 471.003(2) and who is employed by an entity not offering
19 engineering services to the public may use the title
20 "engineer" or any title listed in paragraph (1)(b), except for
21 the terms "professional engineer," "licensed engineer," or
22 "registered engineer," if such use does not indicate that the
23 person is licensed and authorized to practice engineering
24 beyond the scope of the exemptions set forth in s. 471.003(2).

25 This subsection expires July 1, 2004, unless reenacted by the
26 Legislature before that date.
