This section does not prohibit any library, or any business operating jointly with 34 the library, from disclosing information to municipal or county 35 law enforcement officials or to judicial officials or to any 36 business for the purpose of collecting fines or recovering 37 overdue books, documents, films, or other items or materials 38 owned or otherwise belonging to the library. In the case of a 39 public library patron under the age of 16, however, the a public 40 library or business entity may only release confidential 41 information relating to the parent or guardian of the person 42 43 under 16. Any person who violates this section commits is quilty 44 of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in 45 s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
