11	Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

14	(2) The governing board of the authority shall consist
15	of <u>five</u> <del>11</del> voting members, <del>and 1 nonvoting member</del> as follows:
16	(a) The <u>chairs of the</u> county commissions of Seminole,
17	Orange, and Osceola Counties or another member of the
18	commission designated by the chair shall each serve as a elect
19	a commissioner as that commission's representative on the
20	board. The commissioner must be a member of the county
21	<del>commission when elected and</del> for the full extent of his or her
22	term. The terms of the county commissioners on the governing
23	board of the authority shall be 2 years.
24	(b) The <u>mayor</u> mayors of the cities of Altamonte
25	<del>Springs,</del> Orlando, <u>or a member of the Orlando City Council</u> <del>and</del>
26	Kissimmee, or a member of each city commission designated by

(c)(d) The Secretary of Transportation shall appoint the district secretary, or his or her designee, for the б district within which the area served by the authority is located and this member shall be a voting nonvoting member. (3) A vacancy during a term shall be filled by the respective appointing authority in the same manner as the original appointment and only for the balance of the unexpired term. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
