Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the repeal scheduled on October 2, 2003, under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995, section 166.0444, Florida Statutes, is reenacted and amended to read:

166.0444 Employee assistance programs; confidentiality.--

assistance program" means a <u>counseling</u>, therapy, or other <u>professional treatment</u> program provided by a municipality to assist any municipal employee who has a behavioral <u>disorder</u>, or medical disorder, or substance abuse problem, or <u>who has an</u> emotional difficulty <u>that</u> <u>which</u> affects the employee's job performance, through referral for counseling, therapy, or other professional treatment.

(2) Any communication between a municipal employee and personnel or service providers of a municipal employee

assistance program relating to that employee's participation in such program shall be a confidential communication. Any routine monitoring of telephone calls by the municipality does not violate this provision. All personal identifying information contained in records relating to a municipal employee's that participation in an employee assistance program are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2003, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2003. SENATE SUMMARY Revises an exemption from the public-records law to provide for the confidentiality of personal identifying information contained in records relating to a municipal employee's participation in an employee assistance program. Removes the repeal of the exemption scheduled on October 2, 2003, under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995.
