12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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14           Section 1. Sections 468.401, 468.402, 468.403,  
15 468.404, 468.405, 468.406, 468.407, 468.408, 468.409, 468.410,  
16 468.411, 468.412, 468.413, 468.414, and 468.415, Florida  
17 Statutes, are repealed.

18           Section 2. The regulation of talent agencies is  
19 abolished. Any funds and balances associated with the  
20 regulation of talent agencies remaining in the Professional  
21 Regulation Trust Fund after the effective date of this act  
22 shall be used to pay any remaining expenses associated with  
23 this regulation. Any funds or balances remaining in the trust  
24 fund after January 1, 2004, shall be transferred to the  
25 General Revenue Fund.

26           Section 3. The Department of Business and Professional  
27 Regulation may continue to prosecute any legal proceedings and  
28 related administrative cases that are in existence on the  
29 effective date of this act.

30           Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
31 law.
