A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the interception of wire,  
oral, or electronic communications; amending s.  
934.03, F.S.; limiting provisions that allow  
certain officers to intercept such  
communications; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section  
934.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

934.03 Interception and disclosure of wire, oral, or  
electronic communications prohibited.--

(2)

(c) It is lawful under ss. 934.03-934.09 for an  
investigative or law enforcement officer or a person acting  
under the direction of an investigative or law enforcement  
officer to intercept a wire, oral, or electronic communication  
when such person is a party to the communication or one of the  
parties to the communication has given prior consent to such  
interception and the purpose of such interception is to obtain  
evidence of a criminal act related to the investigation of a  
felony, misdemeanor, or noncriminal violation that the officer  
is authorized to enforce.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
