1 Senate Resolution No. ____

2 A resolution recognizing and commending Omega
3 Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., for its invaluable
4 community services to the people of the State
5 of Florida.

7 WHEREAS, on November 17, 1911, three Howard University
8 undergraduate students, assisted by their faculty advisor, met
9 and conceived the idea of founding Omega Psi Phi Fraternity,
10 Inc., based on the cardinal principles of "manhood,
11 scholarship, perseverance, and uplift," and

12 WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., was the first
13 fraternity founded at a Historically Black College or
14 University, and, since its inception, has initiated over
15 130,000 members in 550 chapters in 44 states, the District of
16 Columbia, Europe, Asia, Africa, the Bahamas, the Virgin
17 Islands, and Panama, and

18 WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., is committed
19 to rendering community services that make a difference in
20 quality of life, and has made invaluable contributions toward
21 improving the educational, civic, and social lives of the
22 people it has touched in Florida and throughout the world, and

23 WHEREAS, Brother George H. Grace of Miami, Florida,
24 presently leads Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., serving as the
25 Fraternity's 37th Grand Basileus; Brother Edgar L. Mathis,
26 Sr., of Jacksonville, Florida, is the National Representative
27 for District 7, which includes Florida, Georgia, Alabama, and
28 Mississippi; and Brother Leslie Gamble of Miami, Florida, is
29 the National Representative for the State of Florida, and

30 WHEREAS, other distinguished Floridians who are
31 Brothers of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., include United

1 States Congressman Kendrick Meek, State Senator Anthony C.
2 "Tony" Hill, Sr., State Senator Gary Siplin, State
3 Representative Wilbert "Tee" Holloway, State Representative
4 Frank Peterman, Jr., and Tallahassee Mayor John Marks, NOW,

10 Fraternity, Inc., for its invaluable community service to the
11 people of Florida and recognizes April 3, 2003, as Omega Psi
