4 partnerships, or corporations that provide health care  
5 services by licensed health care practitioners pursuant to  
6 chapters 457, 458, 459, 460, 461, 462, 463, 466, 467, 484,  
7 486, 490, 491, or part I, part III, part X, part XIII, or part  
8 XIV of chapter 468, or s. 464.012, which are wholly owned by  
9 licensed health care practitioners or the licensed health care  
10 practitioner and the spouse, parent, or child of a licensed  
11 health care practitioner, so long as one of the owners who is  
12 a licensed health care practitioner is supervising the  
13 administrative services performed therein and is legally  
14 responsible for the entity's compliance with all federal and  
15 state laws. However, no health care practitioner may supervise  
16 health care delivery services beyond the scope of the  
17 practitioner's license. Supervision of the administrative  
18 services for compliance with federal and state laws is  
19 different and distinct from the supervision of the delivery of  
20 health care services. Health care delivery is the sole  
21 responsibility of the physician delivering health care  
22 services.
