Section 8. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall review and recommend appropriate changes to the laws of this state affecting mold remediation companies, mold remediation contractors, and mold training providers. In conducting the review, the office shall consider input from a variety of sources, including, but not limited to, the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, the Department of Health, the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and the Department of Environmental Protection. The review shall evaluate the need for any changes and additions to those laws which may be appropriate to protect the health, safety, and welfare of consumers. By February 1, 2004, the
