A bill to be entitled
An act relating to the Florida Kidcare Program;
repealing s. 57 of chapter 98-288, Laws of
Florida; abrogating the repeal of the Florida
Kidcare Act; providing an appropriation;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 57 of chapter 98-288, Laws of
Florida, is repealed.

Section 2. The sum of \$527,085 from the Medical Care
Trust Fund and the sum of \$212,683 from the General Revenue
Fund are appropriated to the Agency for Health Care
Administration for the 2003-2004 fiscal year for the purpose
of creating an electronic data interchange between the FLORIDA
system and the data system of the fiscal agent for the Florida
Healthy Kids Corporation.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.

SENATE SUMMARY

Abrogates a repeal of ss. 409.810-409.820, F.S., the
Florida Kidcare Act. Appropriates funds to create an
electronic data interchange between the FLORIDA system
and the data system of the fiscal agent for the Florida
Healthy Kids Corporation.
