Wildflower Trust Fund.--(1) The Wildflower Trust Fund is created within the 13 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Funds shall 14 be credited to the trust fund as provided in Senate Bill 666, 15 to be used for the purposes set forth in that bill. 16 17 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to section 216.351, Florida 18 19 Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any 20 fiscal year must remain in the trust fund at the end of the 21 year and must be made available for carrying out the purposes 22 of the trust fund. 23 (3) In accordance with section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless 24 25 terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2007. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as 26 27 provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect on the effective date of Senate Bill 666, but it shall not take effect unless 29 30 it is enacted by a three-fifths vote of the membership of each 31
