Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, lines 25-31, delete all of said lines

and insert:

Section 2. The City of Miami Beach is authorized and directed to draw a warrant from funds of the municipality not otherwise appropriated in the amount of \$3,217,029.40, less amounts payable pursuant to section 3, payable to Jeffrey Akers as compensation for injuries and damages sustained by Jeffrey Akers as a result of the negligence of the City of Miami Beach. After payment of any outstanding liens not specified in section 3, statutory attorney's fees, and costs, the remaining proceeds shall be payable to Jeffrey Akers.

Section 3. The governmental entity responsible for payment of the warrant shall pay to the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration the amount due under section 409.910, Florida Statutes, prior to disbursing any funds to the claimant. The amount due the agency shall be equal to all
