to be used to pay start-up costs, including costs incurred in developing and issuing the plates. Thereafter, 50 percent of the proceeds shall be distributed to the Children's Home Society of Florida, which must distribute the funds proportionately to each of its divisions, to be used for child abuse prevention programs. The other 50 percent of the proceeds shall be distributed proportionately among the members of the Florida Network of Child Advocacy Centers to fund child abuse intervention programs. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by at least a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature. SENATE SUMMARY Creates a Child Abuse Prevention and Intervention license plate and provides for the distribution of annual use fees to the Children's Home Society and the Florida Network of Child Advocacy Centers to fund child abuse prevention and intervention programs.
