A bill to be entitled
An act relating to license plates; amending ss.
320.08056, 320.08058, F.S.; creating a Child
Abuse Prevention and Intervention license
plate; providing for the distribution of annual
use fees received from the sale of such plates;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (mm) is added to subsection (4)
of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08056 Specialty license plates.--

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall
be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(mm) Child Abuse Prevention and Intervention license
plate, \$25.

Section 2. Subsection (39) is added to section
320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.--

(39) CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION LICENSE
PLATES.--

(a) The department shall develop a Child Abuse
Prevention and Intervention license plate as provided in this
section. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
plate, and the words "Stop Child Abuse" must appear at the
bottom of the plate.

(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the
Children's Home Society and the Florida Network of Children's
Advocacy Centers as follows: The first \$90,000 in annual use
fees shall be equally divided between the two organizations,

1 to be used to pay start-up costs, including costs incurred in
2 developing and issuing the plates. Thereafter, 50 percent of
3 the proceeds shall be distributed to the Children's Home
4 Society of Florida, which must distribute the funds
5 proportionately to each of its divisions, to be used for child
6 abuse prevention programs. The other 50 percent of the
7 proceeds shall be distributed to the Florida Network of
8 Children's Advocacy Centers, which must distribute the funds
9 proportionately to its member centers to fund child abuse
10 intervention programs.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
