A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to district school board  
employees; requiring an employee of a district  
school board who is a member of the Legislature  
to take unpaid leave for time away from  
employment while on legislative business;  
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. District school board employees required to  
take unpaid leave while on legislative business.--An employee  
of a district school board who is a member of the Legislature  
must take unpaid administrative leave for any period of time  
away from his or her place of employment due to legislative  
duties and responsibilities.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.
