Section 1. Subsections (1) and (4) of section 943.10, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

943.10 Definitions; ss. 943.085-943.255.--The following words and phrases as used in ss. 943.085-943.255 are defined as follows:

(1) "Law enforcement officer" means any person who is elected, appointed, or employed full time by any municipality or the state or any political subdivision thereof or who is a special railroad officer appointed pursuant to chapter 354; who is vested with authority to bear arms and make arrests; and whose primary responsibility is the prevention and detection of crime or the enforcement of the penal, criminal, traffic, or

28 highway laws of the state. This definition includes all
 29 certified supervisory and command personnel whose duties
 30 include, in whole or in part, the supervision, training,
 31 guidance, and management responsibilities of full-time law
 32 enforcement officers, part-time law enforcement officers, or
 33 auxiliary law enforcement officers but does not include support
 34 personnel employed by the employing agency.

35 (4) "Employing agency" means any agency or unit of
 36 government or any municipality or the state or any political
 37 subdivision thereof, or any agent thereof, which has
 38 constitutional or statutory authority to employ or appoint
 39 persons as officers. The term also includes any private entity
 40 which has contracted with the state or county for the operation
 41 and maintenance of a nonjuvenile detention facility and any
 42 private entity employing a special railroad officer pursuant to
 43 s. 354.01.
