Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 812.022, Florida Statutes, to read:

812.022 Evidence of theft or dealing in stolen property.--

(5) Proof of possession of misappropriated property that contains identifying or ownership information, whether or not attempts have been made to alter or conceal the identifying or ownership information, gives rise to the inference that the person buying or selling the property knew or should have known that the property had been stolen. A purchaser of property may avoid this inference by contacting the identified owner, if the identifying or ownership information is decipherable, to confirm that the property has not been misappropriated, or, if the identifying or ownership information is not decipherable, by
