25	<u>into custody and delivered to, an emergency room of a</u>		
26	<u>receiving facility for voluntary or involuntary examination</u>		
27	<u>under chapter 394 shall be considered services for emergency</u>		
28	<u>medical conditions under s. 641.47 for the lesser of 72 hours</u>		
29	<u>or until transfer of the patient to an alternative facility.</u>
