A bill to be entitled

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An act relating to direct-support organizations; creating s. 20.193, F.S.; providing for direct-support organizations for the benefit of the Department of Children and Family Services; providing for administration of funds; providing purposes and objectives; requiring funds to be used for the enhancement of department programs and projects; authorizing certain use of state property and facilities; requiring an annual audit; amending s. 20.19, F.S.; authorizing designation of employees to solicit funds; creating s. 430.065, F.S.; providing for direct-support organizations for the benefit of the Department of Elderly Affairs; providing purposes and objectives; requiring funds to be used for the enhancement of department programs and projects; authorizing certain use of state property and facilities; requiring an annual audit; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 20.193, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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20.193 Department of Children and Family Services directsupport organization.--

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(1) As used in this section, the term "direct-support organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated under chapter 617 and organized and operated to conduct programs and activities; initiate developmental projects; raise funds; request and receive grants, gifts, and bequests of moneys; acquire, receive, hold, invest, and administer, in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other property, real or

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personal; and make expenditures to or for the direct or indirect benefit of the Department of Children and Family Services or individual programs or projects of the department.

- (2) A direct-support organization may be organized to accomplish the purposes and objectives set forth in subsection (3). The direct-support organization shall maintain donations and direct service expenditures in a bank account outside of the State Treasury. Any administrative costs of running and promoting the purposes of the corporation shall be paid for by private funds or state appropriations to the extent the receipt of federal funding by the department is not jeopardized.
- (3) The purposes and objectives of the direct-support organization shall be consistent with the priority issues and objectives of the department and shall be in the best interest of the state.
- (4) Funds designated for the direct-support organization shall be used for the enhancement of programs and projects of the department.
- (5) The department may permit, without charge, the appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the direct-support organization subject to the provisions of this section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the approved purpose of the direct-support organization.
- (6) The direct-support organization shall provide for an annual financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981.
- Section 2. Subsection (10) is added to section 20.19, Florida Statutes, to read:
- 20.19 Department of Children and Family Services.—There is created a Department of Children and Family Services.
- (10) SOLICITATION OF DONATIONS TO DIRECT-SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS.--The secretary may designate employees of the

Section 3. Section 430.065, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

430.065 Department of Elderly Affairs direct-support organization.--

- (4) The department may permit, without charge, the appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the direct-support organization, subject to the provisions of this section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the approved purpose of the direct-support organization.
- (5) The direct-support organization shall provide for an annual financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981.
 - Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
