Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2003. 22 23 STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR 24 25 SB 462 26 Specifies the information in the certificate that is exempt. 27 28 Provides that the information is exempt but not confidential and exempt. 29 Removes a provision that permits review of individual certificates, though still permits physicians to obtain the 30 information. 31
