An act relating to controlled substances; amending s. 893.13, F.S.; prohibiting the sale, manufacture, or delivery of controlled substances, or possession of controlled substances with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, within 1,000 feet of certain educational institutions, described housing facilities, and any state, county, or municipal park or publicly owned recreational facility; providing penalties; amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; ranking such offenses on the offense severity ranking chart of the Criminal Punishment Code; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraphs (c), (d), and (f) of subsection (1) of section 893.13, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 893.13 Prohibited acts; penalties.--

Except as authorized by this chapter, it is unlawful 20 (C) for any person to sell, manufacture, or deliver, or possess with 21 intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, a controlled substance 22 in, on, or within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a 23 child care facility as defined in s. 402.302 or a public or 24 private elementary, middle, or secondary school between the 25 hours of 6 a.m. and 12 a.m., or at any time in, on, or within 26 1,000 feet of real property comprising a state, county, or 27 28 municipal park or publicly owned recreational facility.
