Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 4, between lines 15 and 16,

insert:

Section 4. Section 43.195, Florida Statutes, is
transferred to section 90.959, Florida Statutes.

90.959 ~~43.195~~ Disposal of physical evidence filed as
exhibits.--The clerk of any circuit court or county court may
dispose of items of physical evidence which have been held as
exhibits in excess of 3 years in cases on which no appeal is
pending or can be made. Items of evidence having no monetary
value which are designated by the clerk for removal shall be
disposed of as unusable refuse. Items of evidence having a
monetary value which are designated for removal by the clerk
shall be sold and the revenue placed in the clerk's general
revenue fund.
