A bill to be entitled
An act relating to campaign financing;
requiring certain organizations to file
campaign finance disclosure reports; providing
requirements for the contents of, and for the
place and time of filing, such reports;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Independent expenditures by organizations;
reports.--

(1) Any organization that raises money for purposes of
making an independent expenditure in a political campaign must
file campaign finance disclosure reports that disclose the
full name, address, and occupation, if any, of each person who
has made one or more contributions to or for the organization
within the reporting period, together with the amount and date
of such contributions.

(2) The disclosure reports required under subsection
(1) must be filed with the Secretary of State, and the initial
report must be filed at the end of the calendar quarter in
which the organization first accepts a donation for such
purposes. Subsequent reports must be filed on the schedule
applicable to political candidates for office which is set
forth in section 106.07, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires any organization that raises money for purposes of making an independent expenditure in a political campaign to file campaign finance disclosure reports with the Secretary of State. Prescribes the schedule for filing such reports.
