Section 1. This act shall be known by the popular name the
"Sexual Predator Elimination Act."
Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section
794.011, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (11) is
added to said section, to read:
794.011 Sexual battery
(2)(a) A person 18 years of age or older who commits
sexual battery upon, or in an attempt to commit sexual battery
injures the sexual organs of, a person less than 12 years of age
commits a capital felony, punishable as provided in ss. 775.082
and 921.141. Any prosecutor who charges a person with a
violation of this paragraph shall not present or enter into any
plea bargain for a term of imprisonment of less than 15 years
with the accused.
(11) Any person 18 years of age or older who is a sexual
predator as set forth in s. 775.21 and who commits a capital,
