29	(1) As used in this section, the term "direct-support
30	organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated

The direct support organization will maintain donations and direct service expenditures in a bank 12 account outside of the State Treasury. Any administrative 13 costs of running and promoting the purposes of the corporation 14 will be paid for by private funds or state appropriations to 15 the extent the receipt of federal funding by the department is 16 17 not jeopardized. The purposes and objectives of the direct-support 18 (3) 19 organization must be consistent with the priority issues and objectives of the department and must be in the best interest 20 21 of the state. 22 Funds designated for the direct-support (4) organization shall be used for the enhancement of programs and 23 24 projects of the department. 25 (5) The department may permit, without charge, the 26 appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the 27 direct-support organization subject to the provisions of this 28 section. Section 430.065, Florida Statutes, is 11 created to read: 430.065 Department of Elderly Affairs direct-support 12 13 organization. --(1) As used in this section, the term "direct-support 14 organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated 15 under chapter 617 and organized and operated to conduct 16 17 programs and activities; initiate developmental projects; raise funds; request and receive grants, gifts, and bequests 18 19 of moneys; acquire, receive, hold, invest, and administer, in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other 20 property, real or personal; and make expenditures to or for 21 the direct or indirect benefit of the Department of Elderly 22 Affairs or individual programs or projects of the department. 23 (2) The purposes and objectives of the direct-support 24 25 organization must be consistent with the priority issues and objectives of the department and must be in the best interest 26 of the state. 27 28 (3) Funds designated for the direct-support 29 organization shall be used for the enhancement of programs and 30 projects of the department. 31

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(4) The department may permit, without charge, the appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the direct-support organization, subject to the provisions of this section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the approved purpose of the direct-support organization. (5) The direct-support organization shall provide for an annual financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981. Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Creates nonprofit, direct-support organizations for the benefit of the Department of Children and Family Services and the Department of Elderly Affairs. Provides for the purposes and objectives of the organizations. Authorizes the solicitation of funds by designated employees.

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
