An act relating to the East Lake Tarpon Special Fire Control District, Pinellas County; amending sections 3(2) and 11 of section 1 of chapter 2000-477, Laws of Florida; providing authority of the district with respect to land that is annexed by a municipality or other fire control district; providing for collection and payment of fire services taxes or assessments by such municipality or other district; providing for future repeal of the amendments made by the act; providing effective dates.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 3 of section 1 of chapter 2000-477, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 3. Formation; boundaries.--

(2) Any lands within a municipality included in the boundaries of the District, as described herein, shall be
