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CS 29 provided in this section. Property to the value of \$5,000 of 30 such a person is exempt from taxation. The production by him or 31 her of a certificate of disability from the United States 32 Government or the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 33 or its predecessor before the property appraiser of the county 34 wherein the ex-service member's property lies is prima facie 35 evidence of the fact that he or she is entitled to the 36 exemption. The unremarried widow or widower of a disabled 37 veteran who, on the date of the disabled veteran's death, had 38 been married to the disabled veteran for a period of at least 20 39 years is also entitled to such exemption as provided in this 40 section.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
