School districts; school boards.--17 (a) Each county shall constitute a school district; 18 19 provided, two or more contiguous counties, upon vote of the 20 electors of each county pursuant to law, may be combined into one school district. In each school district there shall be a 21 22 school board composed of five or more members chosen by vote 23 of the electors in a nonpartisan election for appropriately staggered terms of four years, as provided by law. 24 25 (b) The school board shall operate, control and supervise all free public schools within the school district 26 27 and determine the rate of school district taxes within the 28 limits prescribed herein. Two or more school districts may 29 operate and finance joint educational programs. 30 (c) A person may not serve as a member of a district school board for more than twelve consecutive years. 1 member of a district school board resigns before completing twelve consecutive years of service and subsequently seeks 2 3 election to the board, the time served before resignation shall be deemed to constitute one four-year term of office for purposes of determining applicability of this subsection. Time served as a member of a school board before the first term to which a person is elected following the election at which this subsection is ratified shall not be counted in determining twelve consecutive years of service. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be 11 placed on the ballot: CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 12 ARTICLE IX, SECTION 4 13 LIMITATION ON TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF A DISTRICT 14 SCHOOL BOARD. -- Proposing an amendment to the State 15 Constitution to provide that a person may not serve more than 16 12 consecutive years, beginning with the election following the election at which this amendment is ratified, as a member 18 of a district school board. 19 20 22 23 28
