Private school students may be transported 27 on public school buses and public school students may be 28 transported on private school buses when there is mutual 29 agreement between the local school board and the applicable 30 private school. Any agreement for private school students to be transported on public school buses must be in accordance 31 1

with sections 768.28(9)(a) and 316.6145, Florida Statutes. Any agreement for public school students to be transported on private school buses must be contingent on the private school bus driver's having adequate liability insurance through his or her employer. б Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. SENATE SUMMARY Provides for the standards of the Department of Transportation to require that the driving records of nonpublic sector bus drivers be checked by the employer at least once each year for suspended or revoked licenses. Provides requirements under which private school students may ride on public school buses and public school students may ride on private school buses.
