Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraphs (b) through (r) of subsection (12) of section 1009.24, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (c) through (s), respectively, and a new paragraph (b) is added to said subsection to read:
 - 1009.24 State university student fees.--
- (12) Each university board of trustees is authorized to establish the following fees:
- (b) A nonrefundable admissions deposit for undergraduate and graduate degree programs in an amount not to exceed \$200. The admissions deposit shall be imposed at the time of a student's acceptance to the university and shall be applied to the student's tuition upon enrollment. In the event that a student does not enroll in the university, the admissions deposit shall be deposited in an auxiliary account of the university and used to expand financial assistance, scholarships, and student academic and career counseling services at the university.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
