An act relating to restoration of civil rights; amending ss. 940.061, 944.293, and 944.605, F.S.; requiring that the Department of Corrections notify an offender, before discharge from supervision, of procedures by which the offender may apply for restoration of civil rights; requiring that the department assist the offender in completing forms required for restoration of civil rights; requiring that the offender acknowledge by signature receipt of such assistance; amending s. 944.705, F.S.; requiring the department to include in its releaseorientation program instruction in the procedures for applying for restoration of civil rights; providing an effective date.

16 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

18 Section 1. Section 940.061, Florida Statutes, is amended 19 to read:

Informing persons about executive clemency and 940.061 20 restoration of civil rights. -- The Department of Corrections 21 shall inform and educate inmates and offenders on community 22 supervision about the restoration of civil rights and assist 23 eligible inmates and offenders on community supervision with the 24 completion of the application for the restoration of civil 25 rights. To document this notification, the department shall 26 obtain the signature of each offender before the offender's 27 discharge acknowledging receipt of assistance in completing the 28 29 forms.

HB 0649 2003 Section 2. Section 944.293, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

Initiation of restoration of civil rights.--With 944.293 32 33 respect to those persons convicted of a felony, the following procedure shall apply: Prior to the time an offender is 34 discharged from supervision, an authorized agent of the 35 department shall obtain from the Governor the necessary 36 application and other forms required for the restoration of 37 civil rights. The authorized agent shall assist the offender in 38 completing these forms and shall ensure that the application and 39 40 all necessary material are forwarded to the Governor before the offender is discharged from supervision. To document compliance 41 with this section, before an offender is discharged from 42 supervision, the department shall obtain the signature of the 43 offender acknowledging receipt of assistance in completing the 44 forms required for restoration of civil rights. 45 Section 3. Present subsection (6) of section 944.605, 46 Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (7), and a new 47 subsection (6) is added to that section, to read: 48 944.605 Inmate release; notification.--49 (6) Before an inmate's release, the department shall 50 notify the inmate of the procedures necessary to apply for 51 restoration of civil rights. Pursuant to ss. 944.293 and 940.03, 52 the department shall obtain the signature of each inmate before 53 the inmate's release acknowledging receipt of assistance in 54 completing the forms. 55 Section 4. Subsection (2) of section 944.705, Florida 56 Statutes, is amended to read: 57 58 944.705 Release orientation program. --
