A bill to be entitled

An act relating to environmental protection; providing a popular name; providing for remediation of contaminated sites in counties and municipalities; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to adopt rules and issue orders; providing for enforcement; providing for control in the event of conflict of provisions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. This act shall be known by the popular name the "Public Resource Protection Act."
- Section 2. <u>Counties and municipalities that own sites with soil or water contamination shall remediate such sites to the same extent as is required for brownfield sites under s. 376.81, Florida Statutes.</u>
- Section 3. The Department of Environmental Protection may adopt such rules and issue such orders as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.
- Section 4. The provisions of this act may be enforced pursuant to ss. 120.69, 120.695, 376.83, 403.141, 403.161, and 403.412, Florida Statutes.
- Section 5. If any provision of this act or of the rules adopted pursuant to this act is in conflict with any other provision, limitation, or restriction which is now in effect under any law of this state or any ordinance of a local government, political subdivision, or municipality, or any rule or regulation adopted thereunder, the provisions of this act or of the rules adopted pursuant to this act shall control;
