Moneys 13 from advance recycle fees paid under section 403.71853, 14 Florida Statutes, shall be deposited into the account and 15 shall be disbursed from the account according to that section 16 17 for the purpose of making grants to counties for establishing programs for recycling or otherwise properly disposing of 18 19 electronics products and components. 20 (2) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the electronics recycling account 21 22 shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2007. Before its scheduled termination, the account shall be 23 reviewed as provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida 24 25 Statutes. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, if 26 27 SB or similar legislation is adopted in the same 28 legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law. 29 30 31
